
- in most cases means that there is a idea (or tactic) to enter the wanted data, as shown here, but that this data is not entered yet.

and: DSK leads to NO RARITY (as it is no buyable/collectable realiron product)






To find all cartridges which were released WITH localizations, just OR-search for "US" and "EU" in the Housings' column: (Office <= 2003)




To find cartridges with a special chip-size, just do this:


(Mostly please do not filter just for "16K", as the are also entries like "16K/80COL" which could not be found then. I recommend to use the user-defined "contains"-filter as shown here below, to get 100% hits. This is valid for ALL filters here, as this is my way to prevent from too many columns in the XLS ©



For example, same for a search (filtering for) 80-colum/F18A-stuff ("80"):




To find all Adventure-related stuff, use this filter here:



After that, you could filter for "DISK" or "CS1" (=Cassette-Releases) in the CAT1-column, only to get the tapes \odot

Please do not re-sort the XLS, there would be alphabetically issues.

If questions, pls ask. If present, please see the other tabs in the XLS.

Also a nice (new) thing is filtering CAT1 for "books" or "doc" or "manual". This is my latest work (unpublished yet):) I think almost all 99-related books a.s.o. can be found there

Sometimes you can find a category twice. I.e. "Tool" in CAT2 and CAT3. I know about, these are things that have to be solved later. Maybe with a CAT4, but I want to prevent from too many columns, as I wrote before.

Misc:

All BOOKS are in an own section,

all MANUALSs are placed directly following after the concerning cartridge, tape or disk, and the DOCs also have a small own section, at the end of the table.
